Join other experienced hematopathologists and share responsibilities that include interpretation of bone marrow aspirates and biopsies, peripheral blood smears, lymph nodes, and other lymphoid tissue consult specimens. Provide subject matter professional expertise for analyzing diseases to provide the highest quality, most accurate, and clinically relevant pathologic diagnoses. Flow cytometric data analysis experience is essential, as well as, the ability to integrate immunohistochemical, cytogenetics, FISH, and molecular genetic results including NGS with morphologic findings.

Although our central lab is located in New Haven, CT, the location for the Hematopathologist in this role is flexible and is not restricted to the lab's physical location. Precipio has perfected a workflow and logistics process that enables remote sign-out of all cases, allowing for a flexible work schedule. Compensation is flexible and based on ability to handle case volume; included are annual bonuses and equity stock options.

Responsibilities

- Morphologically evaluate hematologic and lymphoid processes, integrating clinical data, flow cytometric, immunohistochemical, cytogenetics and molecular genetic findings.
- Incorporate clinical pathological correlation in reports.
- Provide guidance and recommendations to laboratory personnel as needed.
- Provide consultations for oncologists and pathologists on cases as requested or needed.

Qualifications
